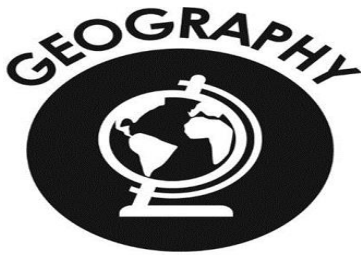


The Learning Challenge CURRICULUM

Geography at Bottesford C.E. Primary School

At Bottesford C.E. Primary School we believe that geography should inspire children with a curiosity and fascination, about the world around them, which will remain with them for life.

Intent:

- We intend for our children to have real life experiences and learn about geography in an active and creative way.
- Wherever possible, quality cross curricular links will be explored.
- The planning of learning always begins with the skills and knowledge that needs to be taught and enrichment opportunities as well as opportunities to apply learning are carefully mapped.
- Children should be equipped with a deep knowledge about diverse places, people, resources and natural and human environments.



Implementation:

From the local village and its facilities to the volcanos of the world, the children at Bottesford C.E. Primary School will be given opportunities to study each area in detail. Children will also gain a deep understanding of the Earth's key physical and human processes. In doing so, children will be encouraged to develop a greater understanding and knowledge of the world, as well as their place in it.
